Use of Site Index

To use the index, find the location reference beside the site name in the appropriate alphabetical listing. For example, (United States Army) Fort Bragg. F18 F18 indicates the 3 degree by 3 degree geographic block where the site occurs. The block is located by reading the East or West margin to letter F and then across the North or South margin to the number 18. The intersecting block is F18.
