

**RESOLUTION SUPPORTING
TESTING OF PRIVATE WELLS AND GROUNDWATER FOR
DEGRADATION PRODUCTS OF DNT**

April 9, 2008

WHEREAS, Dinitrotoluene (DNT) contamination from Badger Army Ammunition Plant has been detected in groundwater in nearby rural neighborhoods, and

WHEREAS, these degradation products are toxic and/or are likely human carcinogens, and

WHEREAS, these degradation products are not specifically targeted for in-laboratory analysis of water samples by the U.S. Army, and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Army has a responsibility to assure that testing of groundwater and private well water is comprehensive and trustworthy,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the following members of the Badger Restoration Advisory Board, that the U.S. Army should immediately add targeted analysis of all degradation products of DNT for all groundwater and drinking water samples.
