The LDEO, Office of Environmental Services, is accepting written comments on a Notice of Intent to Deny the Hazardous Waste Operating Permit Renewal Application for Clean Harbors Colfax, LLC, 3763 Highway 471, Colfax, Louisiana 71417 for the Colfax Open Burning/Open Detonation (OB/OD) Facility. The facility is located at 3763 Highway 471, Colfax, Louisiana, Grant Parish.

Clean Harbors Colfax, LLC, submitted a hazardous waste operating permit renewal application to thermally treat reactive and explosive waste. The LDEQ reviewed the application and all related documents prior to issuing the Notice of Intent to Deny the hazardous waste operating permit.

If LDEQ finds a significant degree of public interest, a public hearing will be held. LDEQ will send notification of the final permit decision to the applicant and to each person who has submitted written comments or a written request for notification of the final decision.
